Every spouse of a veteran should have in his/her personal file the following:

Spouse's Birth Certificate - 3 copies

Children's Birth Certificate - 3 copies

Certificate of Marriage - 3 copies

Wills (for veteran & spouse) - 2 copies

Spouse's Social Security number

Veteran's Social Security number

Discharge papers - 2 copies

Separation records - 2 copies

V.A. "C" number

G.I. Insurance Policy Number

All Insurance Policies with addresses and numbers. (Originals needed)

Cemetery plot or vault locations and numbers

Death Certificates and divorce decree of all prior marriages (if applicable)

Copies of the following are needed to file a Claim for Death Benefit:

Certificate of Marriage
Birth Certificate of minor children
Death Certificates or divorce decrees of all prior marriages on either side
Service discharge papers
Service separation papers
V.A. "C" number
Social Security number of both parties
V.A. insurance papers
Proof of Death Certificate (minimum 4 copies)
Bills from Funeral Home

ALL originals should be kept in a safety deposit box or equivalent.

NEVER release an ORIGINAL copy.

APPOINT an administrator for minor children.
